Kaltura	"YouTube for Education" Accept media submissions from students and share video in your iCollege course. Record your lecture and post your video in your iCollege course. Create one this year and easily use it in future courses. Unlimited, mechanical closed captioning available at no cost; hand closed captioning available through Jill Burdo.
lynda.com	Just in time learning for tools such as Microsoft Word, Outlook, and Excel
MindMeister	Online collaborative mindmapping/concept mapping software - PILOT 2018-2019
Panopto	
PlayPosit	Turn videos into an interactive quiz and easily share it with students. PlayPosit collects and processes the data about student performance and provides visual statistics that target difficult topics and help instructors adjust for student needs.
Practice	A performance based video based tool that allows for self, peer and instructor assessment to improve performance through practice. PILOT 2018-2019
WebEx	Meet online one-on-one or in groups. Share your screen, see each other with video, share documents
WebEx Teams	WebEx on the go. Available for mobile devices, allows for students to create their own collaborative online space without instructor setup.
